THE 2023 ROYAL ST. JOHN'S REGATTA AGE CATEGORIES FOR PARTICIPANTS

Coxswains must be 19 years of age as of December 31 this year and must be certified by the Royal St. John's Regatta Committee.

Minimum age of any oarsperson is 10 years as of December 31 this year.

UI4: Any oarsperson between the age of 10 and 14 as of December 31 this year.

U16: Any oarsperson under the age of 16 as of December 31 this year.

U18: Any oarsperson under the age of 18 as of December 31 this year.

U21: Any oarsperson under the age of 21 as of December 31 this year.

Senior: All registered oarspersons who are not rowing as U14, U16, U18, U21 or Masters.

Women's Masters (41+): An oarsperson whose minimum age shall be 41 years of age as of December 31 this year.

Men's Masters (46+): An oarsperson whose minimum age shall be 41 years of age as of December 31 this year.







Mr. Perlin was instrumental in the St. John's Regatta receiving its "Royal" designation by Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth II in 1993, which remains to this day one of the organization's greatest honours.

For his exemplary volunteerism, Mr. Perlin was named to the Royal St. John's Regatta Committee Hall of Fame in 1994. His lifetime of dedication to the Royal St John's. Regatta Committee culminated in Mr. Perlin being named Honourary Life President in 2022 – a distinction only ever bestowed on two other individuals in the course of the Committee's history.

"The Royal St. John's Regatta Committee grieves the loss of our Honourary Life President, volunteer and friend, Mr. John Perlin. We honour his life by remembering his years of dedication to not only fixed seat rowing in St. John's, but his lifetime of service to countless people and causes throughout Newfoundland and Labrador. His tireless commitment to the Royal St. John's Regatta Committee remains a model of volunteerism and will no doubt continue to inspire future volunteers and those who serve our organization", said Royal St. John's Regatta Committee President Noelle Thomas-Kennell remarked at the time of his passing.

HONOURARY LIFE PRESIDENT MR. BERNARD "TANNY" COLLINS

One of the most prestigious honours to be bestowed upon a Royal St. John's Regatta Committee member is Honourary Life President. So it was with great pleasure that the Royal St. John's Regatta Committee proudly announced the appointment Honourary Life President, Bernard "Tanny" Collins, only the 4th such named in our more than 200 year history, in June 2023.

"The decision to name an Honourary Life President is one our Committee takes very seriously. The position is reserved for those who have shown a deep commitment to our organization and those whose tireless efforts have not only enhanced the Royal St. John's Regatta, but fixed-seat rowing on the whole. Mr. Collins' many years of exemplary service made him an easy choice for this most esteemed designation. We are honoured that he accepted this appointment and thank him for his dedication to the Royal St. John's Regatta", says Royal St. John's Regatta Committee President, Noelle Thomas-Kennell.

Bernard "Tanny" Collins' history with the Royal St. John's Regatta goes back to the late 1960s when he started rowing, though many would say his connection to the Regatta was more of a birthright, passed down from the generations before him. Like his grandfather, Patrick Francis Collins, and his father, Bernard Collins, Tanny happily gave his time and skills, jumping into an organizational role. His contributions to the Regatta are extensive and significant, most notably, acting as Regatta Committee President from 1987-1988. But a few examples of his important work include the establishment of the organization's current governance structure, the Hall of Fame was created, and the vision and funding for the refurbished boathouse began (with the project eventually being completed in 2000). Also in 1988, Tanny oversaw the testing of our race shells by the Institute of Marine Dynamics at MUN.

The wave tank tests showed that the design created by Robert Sexton, the carriage maker and Dr. Rendall, the rowing enthusiast, could not be improved upon.

His commitment to the Royal St. John's Regatta has extended beyond his presidency as evidenced by his family business PF Collins' years of support through the sponsorship of crews, races and trophies, as well as the donation of the racing shell, The Broker. This appointment comes after the passing of Mr. John C. Perlin, CM, CVO, ONL, LLD, in 2022. Previous Honourary Life Presidents include Mr. Jack Reardigan and Mr. Gerry Angel.
