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THE 2026 ROYAL ST. JOHN'S REGATTA AGE CATEGORIES FOR PARTICIPANTS

Coxswains must be 19 years of age as of December 31 this year and must be certified by the Royal St. John's Regatta Committee.

Minimum age of any oarsperson is 10 years as of December 31 this year.

U13: Any oarsperson between the ages of 10 and 13 as of December 31 this year.

U16: Any oarsperson under the age of 16 as of December 31 this year.

U18: Any oarsperson under the age of 18 as of December 31 this year.

U21: Any oarsperson under the age of 21 as of December 31 this year.

Senior: All registered oarspersons who are not rowing as U14, U16, U18, U21, or Masters.

Women's Masters (41+): A woman oarsperson who's minimum of 41 years of age as of December 31 this year.

Men's Masters (46+): A man oarsperson who's minimum of 46 years of age as of December 31 this year.

Open Crew: means a crew whose oarspersons are not identified by gender, and shall be determined by age categories (i.e., gender has no influence on the composition of a crew).

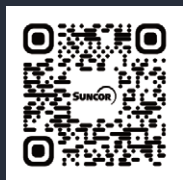
